Day 1 | Sunday, July 7 (Washington, DC to Johannesburg)

All Day Fly from Washington, DC to Johannesburg, South Africa

Day 2 | Monday, July 8 (Johannesburg)

Evening Arrive in Johannesburg and transfer to The Maslow Hotel While traveling into Johannesburg, engage in a comprehensive orientation session to understand and conceptualize the journey ahead, and share program goals and expectations amongst your fellow travelers.

Day 3 | Tuesday, July 9 (Johannesburg)

Morning /Afternoon Tour the historic township of Soweto with a local guide South Western Township, commonly known as Soweto, is a significant municipality in South Africa's history. During this day of touring, visit the Hector Pieterse Memorial, Mandela House, cultural exchange with the local community, and more! Afternoon Visit an indigenous village and meet with local community leaders near Hammanskraal, facilitated by the Kwalata Game Reserve

Morning Company Visit 2

Afternoon Explore the Apartheid Museum and learn about South Africa's complex 20th century history; speak with locals to hear the community perspective

Day 7 | Saturday, July 13 (Johannesburg to Cape Town)

Morning Fly nonstop from Johannesburg to Cape Town (~2 hours); check into the Cape Town Lodge Hotel

Afternoon Group lunch, then ride the aerial cableway to the top of Table Mountain Experience amazing views from the heights of this iconic flat-topped landmark overlooking the city. Table Mountain predates the Andes, the Alps, the Rocky Mountains, and the Himalayas.

Evening Free time and small group dinners along the Cape Town Waterfront

Day 8 | Sunday, July 14 (Cape Town)

Morning/Afternoon A full-day safari tour at Aquila Private Wildlife Reserve Experience one of Africa's natural wildlife reserves while traveling through the park in a 4x4 Jeep with an expert ranger as your guide.
